We are in the United States for a three month home assignment and are looking forward to seeing many of you. Please note our schedule on the other side. We would love to see you at one of these events. Do not hesitate to call or email for more details.

As we returned, we reflected on all that God had accomplished during our last term in Benin and can only say Praise be to God. When we arrived in May of 2007 the Benin transmitting station project was behind schedule. Then by God's marvelous grace on February 1, 2008 TWR started broadcasting biblical teaching and the gospel of our Savior from Benin. On July 5, 2008, we

dedicated the Benin facility to the Lord. Since that time the station in Benin has operated with few problems. Indeed, praise be to our wonderful God.

We have also reflected on some areas that need improvement; one of which is keeping our prayer partners better informed. This has been much more difficult than we anticipated, for a variety of reasons. In an effort to better keep our prayer partners informed we are in the process of launching a web page with a prayer blog. Those interested in praying for us will find regular (we will try for weekly) updates to the prayer requests. We will also have a family blog where you can keep up with the latest on our family. Lord willing, www.cox-net.com, will be operational by February 14.

During our time in the States we are praying that:

1. God will raise up more people to pray for Benin. The real work of the ministry is prayer and we are exceptionally grateful for all who have prayed with us. As we have mentioned, www.cox-net.com will be operational on February 14 with a prayer blog to keep those who pray for us better informed.

Attached you will find our new prayer card and a FAQ sheet which is a great review of what we do here in Benin.

2. God will raise up more workers to come to Benin. Indeed the harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. We are asking God to raise up more workers for TWR (both in Benin and world wide). There is an immediate need for a teacher. In the next three years it will be critical to have at least another engineer in Benin along with a diesel mechanic.

3. God will raise up additional finances for TWR so that the gospel and biblical teaching can be broadcast from Benin. We

are humbled at how faithful you have been in supporting us and by God's grace our support has been adequate. There is a shortfall of \$301,000 per year for programs that TWR has started broadcasting from Benin. In addition, there is a need of \$48,000 to cover capital expense needs in Benin. The enclosed FAQ sheet contains more details on this need and how you can be involved.
