MINISTRY NEWS

In February, TWR in Africa restructured the ministry. Paul and Donna wholeheartedly support this restructuring and truly believe that it positions TWR's ministry to move forward powerfully in Africa. While they are excited to see how the Lord will use this restructuring, it made Paul's position, Director of Discipleship, redundant. Hence, his position was eliminated. Paul's position becoming eliminated in the restructuring has been very bitter sweet. It is sad to see this phase of his ministry come to an end.

Concurrent to the restructuring in TWR, the Lord was working and opened the door for Paul and Donna to teach, research and write at Africa Theological Seminary (ATS – www.atseminary.ac.ke), which is based in Kenya. After much prayer and reflection, Paul and Donna made the decision to leave TWR at the end of June to join the faculty of ATS as missionaries (i.e. they will still be raising prayer and financial support).
